MEETING MINUTES

Saturday, July 10, 2011

The July Meeting of the Civic Association of West Lake Brantley was called to order at 2:10pm at the home of Mike Delahoz located at 2451 Westwood Dr. Longwood, FL 32779.

Discussion regarding violations at the beach park began. Sharon spoke with Deputy Pensa who is now on vacation. He put in a report to patrol the area, especially the beach park between the hours of 11pm-2am and they have the combination to the gate.

Mike will put in an infrared camera as well.

Our neighborhood patrol will be made up of individuals driving to the beach park whenever we are on the way home after dusk. The Sheriff's number to call is 407.665.6650 and the beach park address is 2080 Terrace Blvd. Alison will publish this number in the next newsletter.

Also (to be put in newsletter) a wind surfboard and other items were left at the beach park. Mike Delahoz has confiscated them.

Moving on to the canal treatment; Dana Price suggested that we renew the ASI Contract under the terms that they treat every other month. Sharon motioned to approve this and Alison seconded. All in favor.

Farrell has asked Jerry to trim the beach park and Mike will also talk to him. Farrell has asked him to have it trimmed by Saturday the 16th or we will have an issue as these were the terms agreed to upon his "hire". Farrell is concerned that John will have too much to do if the trimming is not done. Alison will find the original information sent to Jerry to make sure that was the original understanding.

Discussion regarding dead trees at the beach park and boat ramp; Farrell has a quote for \$700 to remove 3 trees. The company will divide up the payments if needed.

We agreed to keep our meetings at 2pm on Sundays as it would allow many of us to attend more frequently without as much conflict. Next meeting will be Sunday, August 7th at 2pm.
